## The Westminster Shorter Catechism

### *The Third Commandment*

**Q. 53. Which is the third commandment?**

A. The third commandment is, Thou shalt not take the name of the Lord thy God in vain: for the Lord will not hold him guiltless that takes his name in vain.

**Q. 54. What is required in the third commandment?**

A. The third commandment requires the holy and reverent use of God's names, titles, attributes, ordinances, word and works.

**Q. 55. What is forbidden in the third commandment?**

A. The third commandment forbids all profaning or abusing of anything whereby God makes himself known.

**Q. 56. What is the reason annexed to the third commandment?**

A. The reason annexed to the third commandment is that however the breakers of this commandment may escape punishment from men, yet the Lord our God will not suffer them to escape his righteous judgment.
